members were only too glad to avail of this opportunity after a grinding session with their taught in the last five months. The day turned out to be a day of joy and mirth, and dance and songs, and

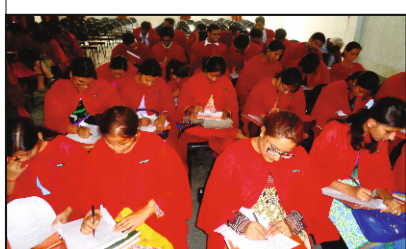
water frolicking, and of course lot of sunshine, which could have been done away with. But Sunshine can never dampen spirit, no matter how high the mercury is, isn't it?
