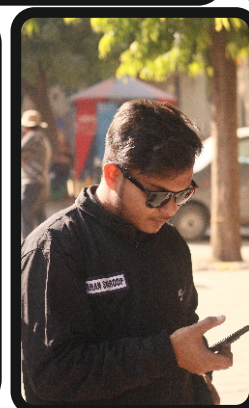


JAIPUR
